

2026 NCCP Competition Coach Evaluation Tools Update Event Policy for Registrants

1. Registration Terms

- **Non-Refundable:** All registrations are final. No refunds will be issued, including for partial attendance or no-shows.

2. Waiver of Liability and Indemnification

By completing registration, the registrant voluntarily assumes all risks associated with participation in the 2026 NCCP Competition Coach Evaluation Tools Update (“The Event”) and agrees to release and hold harmless Alberta Equestrian Federation (AEF), Equestrian Canada (EC), the event venue, and all directors, officers, employees, agents, representatives, contractors, and volunteers of the Hosts (collectively “the Hosts”) from any and all liability for loss, injury, or damage to persons or property incurred during or in connection with The Event.

The registrant further agrees to indemnify and defend the Hosts against any claims, liabilities, damages, or expenses (including legal fees) arising from their actions or conduct while attending The Event.

3. Photographic & Video Consent

By attending The Event, registrants acknowledge that photos and video footage may be taken by the Hosts or their authorized representatives during sessions and activities. These images may be used in promotional, marketing, or reporting materials related to The Event or future initiatives of the Hosts. Registrants waive any right to inspect or approve the use of such imagery and will receive no compensation for its use.

4. Code of Conduct

All registrants are expected to behave in a professional and respectful manner toward all other attendees, presenters, and event staff. Disruptive, discriminatory, or inappropriate behavior may result in removal from The Event without refund. The Hosts reserve the right to deny entry or remove any participant at their sole discretion.

5. Force Majeure

The Hosts shall not be liable for any loss, damage, or additional expenses arising from delay, cancellation, or change in The Event schedule due to causes beyond their control, including but not limited to weather, natural disasters, strikes, government regulations, pandemics, or public health emergencies. The Hosts reserve the right to adjust, postpone, or cancel The Event, and may issue refunds or credits at their discretion.

6. Agreement to Terms

By registering for and attending The Event, the registrant confirms they have read, understood, and agree to be bound by the terms outlined in this Event Policy. Registrants under the age of 18 must have consent from a parent or legal guardian.
